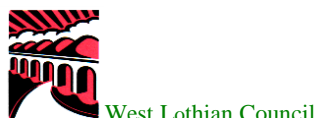
Please ensure that you have returned a completed EE2 form to Cedarbank School, as per Mrs Lindsay's letter last week.
