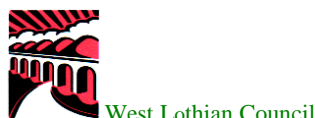
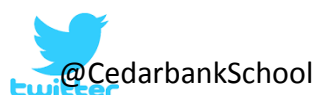
One of the students from the university met with all the pupils involved on Wednesday 27th March to introduce herself and to explain what she, and her colleague, are planning to do in the classes.
