Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted to inform you that, in partnership with our Parent/Carer Council, we will be holding a Summer Ball for our Leavers and our new S6 Pupils. As a parent of one of these pupils I would like to invite you and your family to attend our Ball. I am also pleased to extend an invitation to the parents/carers and family of those pupils who are or were in S4 or S5 and who will also be leaving us at the summer. This is an opportunity for our senior pupils to celebrate the end of this academic year as a Cedarbank pupil, to look forward to what lies ahead, and to mark the departure and graduation from school of our School Leavers.

The Summer Ball will take place on the evening of Friday 21st June 2019 at Uphall Golf Club from 7.30pm till 11.30pm. The dress code for the evening is formal wear. We have, as always, tried to keep costs to a minimum. This invitation extends to your son/daughter and 2 members of your family who may wish to accompany them. The tickets for the event are £5 per person and include a disco and a buffet meal. This cost, plus the purchase of a Leaver's Hoodie for all pupils who are leaving us to move on to pastures new, will be subsidised from school funds.

Although the formal event will officially begin at 7.30pm in **Uphall Golf Club**, we will be holding a Summer Ball Reception at 7pm. This will be an opportunity for friends & family who may not be able to attend the Ball to gather and mark this occasion. At the Reception, there will be an opportunity for you all to have photographs taken as a family. Photographs, once developed, will be made available to you courtesy of Cedarbank School. If you or other family members are unable to join us for this celebration can I ask that you ensure that appropriate arrangements are made for your child to be collected from the venue **prior to 11.30pm**.

In keeping with West Lothian Council policy for all school functions, the sale and consumption of alcohol for this event is strictly prohibited. The parents/carers of any unaccompanied pupil, believed to be under the influence of alcohol, will be contacted and asked to make arrangements for their son/daughter to be collected from the venue.

I commend this night to you and trust that it will be a fitting and memorable celebration of your child's education here at Cedarbank School.
