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Dear Parent/Carers,

We are pleased to announce that Cedarbank School will continue to run a Paired Reading programme for S3, assisted by volunteers from local community group, the Elderberries. We trialled this programme last session and were overwhelmed by how beneficial our young people found it. Every pupil reported having enjoyed the programme and feeling significant improvement in their confidence as well as their literacy skills.

Paired reading is a very effective, evidence-based method of helping children and young people progress in their reading and boost confidence. It was developed by Professor Keith Topping and is an ideal way of helping your child to become a more independent reader. Paired Reading works by building up the positives and focusing on successes in reading, rather than concentrating on mistakes.

The Paired Reading programme will be used alongside our usual curriculum. It is not intended to replace other English/literacy teaching but rather is incorporated into lessons to support pupils' literacy development and general confidence. Each S3 class will have one session a week during S3 English time on either a Monday or Friday from September 9th 2019 onwards.

All volunteers are trained and PVG checked and Cedarbank staff will be present. We look forward to welcoming the Elderberries back to Cedarbank School and are excited to see how well this programme can continue to work for our young people.
