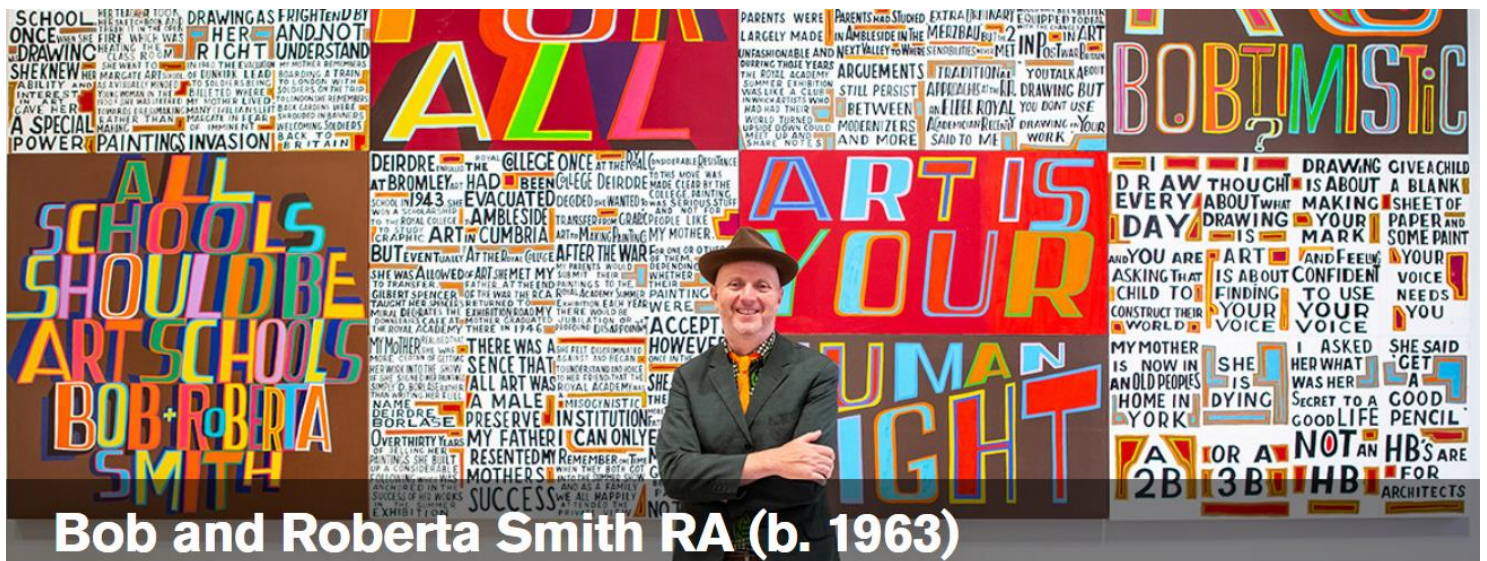


Slogans and the Tree of Life

A lot of Bob and Roberta Smith's work uses words – his art is often about making 'slogans'.

Task 1:

Look online and find your favourite slogans painted by Bob and Roberta Smith.
