
Slogans and the Tree of Life

Task 1:

Task 2:

- 6. If you have colour please add colour to your slogan writing artwork.

Task 3:

Look at Bob and Roberta Smith's example of a table top 'Tree of Life' below. He was inspired by the artist Paul Klee who saw trees as a **life force**.

Create your own 'Tree of Life' with items from the kitchen. You then have the choice to either
