COVID-19 Risk Assessment S1-3 Overview (v.1)



Arrival at school

- Taxis will park in the taxi rank. Pupils will not disembark until a member of Cedarbank staff invites them to do so.
- Pupils will walk into school one taxi grouping at a time.
- Pupils will be asked to use hand sanitiser on entry to school.
- Staff will monitor the safe route planned from taxi rank to Tutor room.
- If parents/carers choose to bring their children to school they should wait, 2m socially distanced, at the front of the school and office staff will manage this entry to the building.

Departure from school

- Each Tutor group has been allocated an exit door from the school.
- Pupils will be escorted by staff to the taxi rank area and supervised on entry to their taxi.

Break times

- S1-3 will have staggered break times and staff will monitor these breaks outside.
- Handwashing will take place before and after break
- Staff supervising will do so observing 2m distancing from each other and wearing facemasks and/or visors.
- Pupils should not bring personal items eg. comforters to school.

Lunches

- Pupils can order a hot lunch during period 1 if they choose to do so.
- Lunchtimes will be staggered.
- Pupils will be served their hot meal in a takeaway container, with disposable cutlery.
- Pupils will eat their lunch in their designated seat in their classroom.
- Handwashing will take place before and after.
- Pupils will be escorted to the outside play area to enjoy some fresh air.

Some specifics within school

- Pupils will keep to the Right Hand Side in corridors.
 - There will be no visitors in school.
 - Pupils are welcome to wear face coverings.
- Water fountains are not in use. Sealed bottles of water are available in addition to water bottles brought in from home.
 - The school library is closed.
 - Pupils will not share equipment.
 - School bags should be kept on the floor.
 - A Daily Bulletin will remind pupils of key messages.

Hand washing and sanitising

- All pupils will be required to wash their hands frequently throughout the school day.
- Hand sanitiser is available around the school and each staff member has a portable dispenser to issue to pupils if required.
 - Staff will remind pupils to wash hands after visiting the toilet and on re-entry to the classroom.
 - Pupil are welcome to bring in their own hand sanitiser for their personal use.

Staff within school

- Staff will observe 2m social distancing.
 - Staff will wear facemasks.
 - Some staff may wear a visor.
- Staff dealing with any First Aid incidents will wear PPE to include gloves and an apron.
- Staff are briefed immediately on any changes to WLC or Scottish Government guidance.
