Dear Parents and Carers,

## Re: Outdoor Learning Lessons

As we approach the colder end of the year, I would like to make a hot drink for the students to have as part of the Outdoor Learning lesson on Monday afternoons. I will prepare the hot water for the drinks using an outdoor Kelly Kettle. A Kelly Kettle is heated using a small fire in a pot at the base of the kettle.

To ensure the safety of all students, I have carried out a full risk assessment. Students will initially watch how to build the small fire in the base of the kettle, and I will talk through all the safety precautions required when boiling water. Eventually, I will allow the students to help collect and lay the wood for building the fire, but only I will light the fire and handle the kettle.

We will provide each student with their own mug in a sealed bag. We will also provide a variety of hot drinks to choose from: hot chocolate, tea etc. We will include this activity as part of the Outdoor Learning programme from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November.
