**For the attention of the parents/carers of pupils in S1/S2 who are involved in remote learning.**

Welcome back to school following the February holiday. It is so nice to feel warmth in the air!

Your child will have recently received the latest pack of learning materials. These form the basis of lessons beginning on **Monday 22nd February until Friday 26<sup>th</sup> February**. Teachers continue to post teaching materials and sessions on TEAMS to support pupils who are remote learning at this time. Pupils in school are now following a different timetable and as a result we have had to change teacher provision for remote learners.

Detailed below is a programme of TEAMS times for your child where teaching staff will be on the **TEAM S1/S2** at certain times in the week to discuss and direct through certain subjects in the learning pack. Please assist your child by having those subject materials ready.

We are aware of the importance of time for your child to socialise with peers. The socialisation session is now scheduled at the following time from week beginning 22nd February and will be on TEAM S1/S2: **Thursdays 3.00 - 3.20pm led by Mrs Keir**. Pupils who are remote learning should only use TEAM S1/S2 for the socialisation and teacher led sessions, and their original Tutor Group TEAM at all other times.
