I hope that this letter finds you and your family well as we continue to work together to support your child, in their learning, during this period of lockdown.

By now, after discussions with you, Mr Sam Morgan will have met with your child to put the final plan A in place for their school leaver destination. As the weeks progress, this will also include, where required, a Plan B alternative which also supports the employment aspirations that your child may have.
