Merry Christmas! 2022 has been a significant year for Cedarbank as we finally joined together as one school community in our beautiful new building. Our learners and staff have enjoyed getting to know each other again while also warmly welcoming the two new S1 classes into Cedarbank. For the first time in many years, we have been able to establish a full Pupil council, have regular, assemblies, whole school events and excursions which have brought connection, learning opportunities and enjoyment to all.

Community links and partnerships has been an area of focus for us this term. Our partnership with James Young High School has developed, enabling learners from both schools to extend their options and learning opportunities. Our new partnership with Livingston Designer Outlet has allowed us increased learning spaces, opportunities for learning in context, support for our Parent and Carol singing events and work experience opportunities. We also need to extend our sincere thanks to the Parent Council who managed to secure funding for the recent bowling trip and have recently been successful in a bid to support finance for the residential school camp. The invitation to come along to our next Parent Council meeting on the 25th January at 6pm is warmly extended to you all.

We wish you all a Christmas break filled with laughter and good health. We look forward to welcoming back your children on the 9th of January.






